

## Reference: Agriculture and gardening

Crop: Raspberries

Place of cultivation: Rudkøbing, Denmark

**Goal of treatment:** In 2005 wilted leaves and a loss of shoots was observed in a 6 year old raspberry plantation. The problem grew rapidly and in 2006 the *Verticillium* sp. was noted in a soil test.

**Application:** In 2007 Terra Biosa was applied with the aim to strengthen the plants to enable them to resist a similar attack. Terra Biosa was sprayed once a week before picking and again four times after picking.

**Result:** A remarkable effect was clear. New shoots grew on large bare patches and re-planted plants were able to grow normally. In addition, there was no trace of grey mould in 2007, confirming that Terra Biosa can be used to prevent attacks.
